This annual festival is open to all piano students, and provides an opportunity for hardworking, well-prepared students to be evaluated against a standard of excellence and encouraged by suggestions for improvement. Each performer will receive a comment sheet, festival ribbon, and a certificate for participation in the festival. Recitals will be in one-hour segments. Parents, family, friends, and teachers are invited to attend.

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## REGULATIONS

**1. FEES:** Registration fee of **\$15.00 to be paid by each student of an OMTA teacher**, or **\$17.00 fee to be paid by each student of a non-OMTA teacher**, payable by/through the teacher.

Teachers shall submit **one check payable to NW District OMTA** for the total amount due from all students.

Due to event costs, fees are non-refundable.

## 2. APPLICATION PREPARATION:

**Applications, fees and the form listing student names must be POSTMARKED by December 10, 2026.**

Applications will not be accepted without payment.

**Repertoire changes can be accepted until January 8<sup>th</sup>, with pieces of the same time length (or less).**

Please make copies of the form that will be used by the adjudicators and complete each individual application legibly. No reductions or enlargements are allowed.

Circle the last names of family members who wish to perform in the same hour. **STAPLE** these applications together.

**DUETS:** Applications of students playing a duet should be stapled together.

Teachers are required to volunteer the day of the festival. Indicate A.M. or P.M. on the student name form.

## 3. TIME REQUIREMENTS:

Beginners (Level IB to Level III): One piece, minimum 16 measures, 3 minute limit.

Intermediate to Advanced: One piece, 8 minute limit.

Students may be stopped if their piece exceeds the time limit.

## 4. MUSIC AND PERFORMANCE:

A clean, published edition of the music must be presented for each performer, including duets.

To avoid confusion, siblings should not share music needed for the judges' use. **No photocopies** will be accepted.

**ALL measures MUST be numbered.**

No music that is an adaptation, transcription or simplification is permitted in MTNA-OMTA sponsored events.

Solo music must be memorized for performance. Duet music need not be memorized.

## 5. STUDENTS:

Must wear proper public performance attire.

Please arrive 15 minutes prior to the starting time of your assigned concert hour, or earlier if planning to warmup in one of the three practice room areas. Signs will direct you to the practice areas and restrooms. Out of respect for those performing in the sanctuary, please proceed to these areas quietly. Thank you!!
